Why We Veil Images from the 5th Sunday in

Lent? You will notice today that all statues and images in church are veilied. Bishop Elliott remarks, "The custom of veiling crosses and images...has much to commend it in terms of religious psychology, because it helps us to concentrate on the great essentials of Christ's work of Redemption." The historical origin of 'veiling' possibly derives from a ninth century German practice of extending a large cloth before the altar from the beginning of Lent. The rule of limiting this

veiling to Passiontide (that is, the final two weeks of Lent) is of seventh century origin; following the Second Vatican Council (AD 1962 to 1965) the veiling of crucifixes and images became optional.
