Parish First Holy Communion Programme

If your child will be in year 3 or above from *September 2023* and you would like to enrol them on the Parish 'First Holy Communion Programme' please e-mail the parish office as soon as possible at:

We will send you an application form which will need to be completed and returned to the parish office with a copy of your child's Catholic Baptism Certificate. If your child was baptised in the parish at either St Thomas Aquinas or All Saints Church, we will already have your child's Holy Baptism Certificate.

If your child will be in year 3 at St Thomas Aquinas School or in year 3 or 4 at Bishop Parker School, there is a separate programme and you do not need to enrol in this Parish Course. Children in school years 3 and 4 will join the Wednesday session 6:00pm – 7:00pm (Group One) children in years 5 & 6 will join the Saturday session 3:00pm-4:00pm (Group 2). The course will begin on Wednesday, 13th September and Saturday, 16th September 2023 respectively and will take place every Saturday / Wednesday thereafter in St Thomas Aquinas Church Meeting Room (MK2 2JE). Holy Communion Plate...

The communion paten/plate is a simple and subtle way of underlining that communion is no mere symbolic token of communal belonging but a genuine participation in the Redeemer's divine flesh. A Communion paten is a small plate that is held by an altar server or acolyte during the distribution of Holy Communion. It is placed under the chin or the hands of the communicant to ensure that the host, or particles of the host do not fall to the ground.

"The Eucharistic presence of Christ begins at the moment of the consecration and endures as long as the Eucharistic species subsist. Christ is present whole and entire in each of the species and whole and entire in each of their parts, in such a way that the breaking of the bread does not divide Christ." (CCC 1377; cf. Council of Trent, Session XIII, Canon III)
