Safeguarding Training

There have been changes to the requirements when volunteering for the first time or when renewing your DBS certificate. From 1st August 2024 all new volunteers are expected to have completed the new safeguarding training PRIOR to their commencement in role and prior to the production of the clearance letter.

All existing volunteers are expected to complete the training before the point of their next DBS renewal. The training level that you need to complete is: Volunteer Level 3/ Advanced DBS with barred list check. This is a mandatory requirement and a national non-negotiable, however, there are many benefits of increased understanding and confidence around safeguarding.

This beautiful statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary was blessed at the Chapel of the Apparitions at Fatima, Portugal in 2018 to prepare the faithful for the Centenary of the Pontevedra apparition. On 10th December 1925, Our Lord and Our Lady requested the communion of Reparation on the Five First Saturdays. Pope St John Paul II said the Fatima message "is the true Gospel of Christ presented anew to our generation... Let us receive the light that comes from Fatima, let us be guided by Mary." All are invited and encouraged to come and see this beautiful CPVSIHM with the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco.
