This Feast, formerly called the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, was often referred to as Candlemas since traditionally on this day the candles that were to be used in Church for the coming year were blessed, and there was often a procession; it also marked the end of the Christmas Season. This Feast is an ideal opportunity for us all to reflect on our Faith and how through Baptism we are called to be 'a light to others' by the example of our lives. We ask the blessing of Our Lord on all our families and may the prayers of Our Lady and St Joseph assist us all to be beacons of light, hope and joy helping to share the love of Christ with everyone we meet.
