Catholic Association Lourdes Pilgrimage 2025

As we celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes this week, have you felt Our Lady's request to travel to Lourdes? Northampton Diocese joins the Catholic Association Pilgrimage to Lourdes each summer - 22nd to 29th August this year. The Pilgrimage is fully medically supported with Doctors, Nurses, HCAs, Paramedics, Pharmacist and other allied health professionals. There are many roles on the Pilgrimage: Young helpers (16 to 25), Mature helpers (26+), Medically trained volunteers and Pilgrims (able-bodied or who require assistance in a hotel or the "Accueil" - similar to hospital wards). Independent pilgrims, who make their own travel and accommodation arrangements, are also welcome (This often suits families best).
