Changes to the DBS Update Service:

Subscribers to the Update Service will be emailed 30 days before their renewal date to ask if they wish to stay subscribed. DBS advises volunteers to check that the email address attached to their subscription is linked to the individual who is subscribed. The renewal email will ask volunteers to access their Update Service Account and confirm that they wish to continue with the service. For those who confirm, this request will be repeated annually. If no confirmation is made, their volunteer subscription will automatically be cancelled.

We will send you an application form which will need to be completed and returned to the parish office with a **copy of your child's Catholic Baptism Certificate.** If your child was baptised in the parish at either St Thomas Aquinas or All Saints Church, we will already have your child's Baptism Certificate.

If your child will be in year 3 at St Thomas Aquinas School or in year 3-6 at Bishop Parker School, there is a separate programme, and you do not need to enrol in this Parish Course. Children in school years 3 and 4 will join the Wednesday session 5:45pm – 7:00pm (Group One) children in years 5, 6, & 7+ will join the Saturday session 4:00pm-5:15pm (Group 2). The course will begin on Wednesday, 10th September and Saturday, 13th September 2025 respectively and will take place every Saturday / Wednesday thereafter in St Thomas Aquinas Church Meeting Room (MK2 2JE).

Weekly participation at the Sunday Mass and full course attendance is essential to complete the Programme.

There will be an Introductory Meeting for Parents at 6:00pm on Monday, 8th September at St Thomas Aquinas Church (MK2 2JE). The course also includes preparation for the Sacrament of First Confession. Further details will be sent with enrolment forms on application to the Parish Office.

Two New Saints

This Sunday the Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, will canonise Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati: two new Saints! Carlo Acutis, who died in 2006 at the age of 15 is called the "cyber-apostle of the Eucharist." Born in London, Carlo used his love of technology to spread devotion to Christ truly present in the Blessed Sacrament and he carried out great research into Eucharistic miracles. His deep faith and holy way of life has inspired countless young people around the world. Pier Giorgio Frassati, who died in 1925 at the age of 24 from polio, was noted for his zest for life, generosity to the poor, and devotion to prayer. Nicknamed "the man of the Beatitudes" by Pope John Paul II, he is a model of faith-filled action in the world. Loving Father, you call your sons and daughters to holiness in every time and place. We thank you for the shining witness of Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, who lived with joy, courage, and love for Christ. Through their example, inspire us to place the Eucharist at the heart of our lives, to serve the poor with generosity, and to live our faith with youthful zeal. Grant that, through their prayers, our families and communities may grow in holiness. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
