The "O" Antiphons

The 7 antiphons sung at the Magnificat on the days before the vigil of Christmas, each beginning with the exclamation "O" and a plea for the Messiah to come.

December 17 O Sapientia O holy word of God, you govern all creation with your strong yet tender care: come and show your people the way to salvation.

December 18 O Adonai O Leader of the House of Israel, who showed yourself to Moses in the burning bush, who gave him the holy law on Sinai mountain: come, stretch out your mighty hand to set us free.

December 19 O Radix Jesse O Root of Jesse, you have been raised up as a sign for all peoples; kings stand silent in your presence; the nations bow down in worship before you. Come, let nothing keep you from coming to our aid.

December 20 O Clavis David O Key of David, controlling at your will the Gate of Heaven: come, break down the prison walls of death for those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death; and lead your captive people into freedom.

December 21 O Oriens O Radiant Dawn, splendour of eternal light, sun of justice: come, shine on those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death.

December 22 O Rex Gentium O King of all the nations, the only joy of every human heart; O Keystone of the mighty arch of man: come and save the creature you fashioned from the dust.

December 23 O Emmanuel O Emmanuel, king and lawgiver, desire of the nations, Saviour of all people: come and set us free, Lord our God.
