Car Parking at All Saints

We received complaints both from parishioners and residents due to poor parking in the car park at All Saints Church at the 9am and 11am Masses. Please remember to fill up the bays **closest** to the Church first. By parking on the perimeter before other bays have been filled it prevents access to free bays. Please Park considerately and don't simply abandon a vehicle in a rush to get into Mass.

Please do not park in bays marked "Resident Only" or on the double yellow lines in Corfe Crescent.

The local authority has been informed about parking infringements and action will be taken in the way of fines etc if people park illegally.

If you need to drive away quickly after Mass, it is best to arrive early and park legally and considerately on the roads around the Church rather than using the car park which takes time to clear after Mass.

Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima

On 26th/27th September, the World Apostolate of Fatima – England and Wales is bringing to our parish the Centenary Pilgrim Virgin Statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (CPVSIHM). This beautiful statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary was blessed at the Chapel of the Apparitions at Fatima, Portugal in 2018 to prepare the faithful for the Centenary of the Pontevedra apparition. On 10th December 1925, Our Lord and Our Lady requested the Communion of Reparation on the Five First Saturdays.

Pope John Paul II said the Fatima Message "is the true Gospel of Christ presented anew to our generation... Let us receive the light that comes from Fatima, let us be guided by Mary." All are invited and encouraged to come and see this beautiful CPVSIHM with the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco. Please see programme at back of church. All Welcome.

If your child will be in Year 3 or above from **September 2026** and you wish to enrol them in the Parish 'First Holy Communion Programme' please e-mail the parish office as soon as possible at: parish.bletchley@northamptondiocese.org with the following details:

We will send you an application form which will need to be completed and returned to the parish office with a **copy of your child's Catholic Baptism Certificate**.

If your child was baptised in the parish at either St Thomas Aquinas or All Saints Church, we will already have your child's Baptismal Certificate.

If your child will be in year 3 at St Thomas Aquinas School or in year 3-6 at Bishop Parker School, there is a separate programme, and you do not need to enrol in this Parish Course.

Children in school years 3 and 4 will join the Wednesday session 5:45pm – 7:00pm (Group 5, 6, One) children in years & 7+ will join the Saturday session 4:00pm-5:15pm (Group 2). The course will begin on Wednesday, 16th September and Saturday, 19th September 2026 respectively and will take place every Saturday / Wednesday thereafter in St Thomas Aquinas Church Meeting Room (MK2 2JE).

Weekly participation at the Sunday Mass and full course attendance is essential to complete the Programme.

There will be an Introductory Meeting for Parents and children to attend. Dates will be notified on application. The course also includes preparation for First Confession. Further details will be sent with enrolment forms on application to the Parish Office.

This Weekend SVP Retiring Collection
