Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima

Next weekend, 26th/27th September, the World Apostolate of Fatima – England and Wales is bringing to our parish the Centenary Pilgrim Virgin Statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (CPVSIHM). This beautiful statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary was blessed at the Chapel of the Apparitions at Fatima, Portugal in 2018 to prepare the faithful for the Centenary of the Pontevedra apparition. On 10th December 1925, Our Lord and Our Lady requested the Communion of Reparation on the Five First Saturdays.

Pope John Paul II said the Fatima Message "is the true Gospel of Christ presented anew to our generation... Let us receive the light that comes from Fatima, let us be guided by Mary." All are invited and encouraged to come and see this beautiful CPVSIHM with the Relics of Saints Jacinta and Francisco.
